Thank you for your letter of 6th July to Andrew Duff enquiring about our plans for the future. Andrew has asked me to respond to you on his behalf.

Climate change is an important issue that RWE npower is committed to playing its part in addressing. Our plans were set out in our recent press release of 9th August 2007 entitled '*RWE npower to cut CO₂ levels by a third, identifies contractor for £800m new gas power station*' available from our website www.npowermediacentre.co.uk.

In this press release we explain our plans for investment in low carbon generation and how this will reduce the amount of carbon dioxide that we emit by around 33% by 2015 based on 1990 levels. As a commercial organisation we strive to achieve carbon reductions whilst delivering the returns our shareholders require from us.
